



IRON MEN EDUCATIONAL REIMBURSEMENT APPLICATION

- Available to SBC lead bivocational pastors who receive the majority of their salary from a job outside the church they are serving or a lead church planter.
- Students are required to have completed a bachelor's degree.
- Reimbursement can be for any of the six Southern Baptist Convention seminaries of your choice or Union University that offers a 100% online master's degree program.
- Individuals contact their school of choice and get the cost of each class/credit hour and number of classes/hours required to complete the degree.
- Students must qualify for the reimbursement through North American Mission Board (NAMB) by submitting an application.
- Individuals will then register through the school.
- Individuals will pay out of pocket for the classes, complete a semester, and once grades have been received, submit to NAMB for reimbursement.
- Grades must be B or above.
- NAMB will send a check to the individual upon receipt of grades and proof of payment.
- Maximum reimbursement each year is \$2,400.
- Reimbursement is limited and a new request must be approved each semester prior to registering.
